Friday 1 June

St Justine

Saint Justine (100 AD), also known as Justin Martyr was an early Christian apologist and is regarded as the foremost interpreter of the theory of the Logos in the 2nd century. He was martyred, alongside some of his students. Most of his works are lost, however two apologies and a dialogue survive.

Anglicanism was brought to the New World by explorers and colonists with the first celebration of the Holy Eucharist in Jamestown, Virginia, in 1607. There was no resident Bishop for nearly two hundred years. In 1784, the Scottish Episcopal Church consecrated the first American Bishop. The Church has 9 Provinces, with 98 Dioceses and 20 overseas jurisdictions.

Prior to 1990, the northern two thirds of Nigeria was largely blocked, but eight new bishops were then consecrated. It is the second largest province in the Anglican Communion, by baptized membership, after the Church of England. Since 2002, the Church of Nigeria is organised in 10 ecclesiastical provinces. It has rapidly

increased the number of its dioceses and bishops from 91 to 122. There are 3,680 Anglican and the administrative headquarters are in Abuja.

The Universities Mission to Central Africa and the Church Missionary Society began work in 1864 and 1878 at Mpwapwa. The Province was inaugurated in 1970 following the division of the Province of East Africa into the Province of Kenya and the Province of Tanzania. The 19 dioceses represent both evangelical and Anglo-Catholic Churches. There are 16 bishops and out of the total population, there are about 2 million Anglicans.

Tuesday 5 June

St Boniface

Saint Boniface, born in the kingdom of Wessex in Anglo-Saxon England, was a leading figure in the Anglo-Saxon mission to the Germanic parts of the Frankish Empire during the 8th century. He established the first organized Christianity in many parts of Germania. He is the patron saint of Germania, the first archbishop of Mainz and the "Apostle of the Germans". He was killed in Frisia in 754, his remains were returned to Fulda, where they rest in a sarcophagus which became a site of pilgrimage.

Historically as a Spanish colony, the Philippines were predominantly Roman Catholic. When Americans colonized the country in 1898, Anglican missionary work began in the north and in the south. Four dioceses were established by 1971 and the Church consecrated its first Bishop in 1963. It became an

Thomas Ken

Thomas Ken was an English cleric who was considered the most eminent of the English non-juring bishops, and one of the fathers of modern English hymnody. Thomas died in 1711 in retirement at Longleat. He was buried at the Church of St John the Baptist, Frome.

Saturday 9 June

St Columba

Saint Columbus (Columba) studied in monastic schools and received bardic training in Irish poetry and literature. When he became a priest his family (Irish royal houses) gave him a fort (later Londonderry) where he established his first monastery. For fifteen years he preached and founded monasteries in Ireland. After a tribal war he had to leave Ireland and arrived at Iona then Evangelised the Picts with missions to Inverness, Ardnamurchan, Skye, Kintyre, Loch Ness and Lochaber.

Tracing its origins to St. Patrick and his companions in the fifth century, the Irish Church has been marked by strong missionary efforts. In 1537, the English king was declared head of the Church. A General Synod of the Church, established in 1890 and consisting of Archbishops, Bishops, and representatives of the clergy and laity, has legislative and administrative power. The Church of Ireland covers the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland, there are 12 Dioceses and around 450 parishes.

The Mexican Episcopal Church symbolically began with Mexico's war for independence in 1810. Religious reform in 1857 secured freedom of religion, separating the Roman Catholic Church from government and politics. In 1860, the newly formed Church of Jesus contacted the Episcopal Church in the United States, seeking leadership, guidance, and support. In 1958, the fourth missionary Bishop of Mexico was the first of the Church's Bishops to be consecrated on Mexican soil. The Church became an autonomous Province of the Anglican Communion in 1995. .

Great emphasis is being placed on training personnel for an indigenous ministry. The island locations and scattered settlements make pastoral care both difficult and costly.

Evelyn Underhill was born 6 December 1875 and died 15 June 1941. She was an English, an Anglo-Catholic writer known for her numerous works on religion, spiritual practice and Christian matters.

The Province is the oldest in Africa. British Anglicans met for worship in Cape Town after 1806, with the first Bishop appointed in 1847. The 23 dioceses of the Province extend beyond the Republic of South Africa and include the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (St Helena and Tristan da Cunha), Mozambique (Lebombo and Niassa), the Republic of Namibia, the Kingdom of Lesotho, the Kingdom of Swaziland and Angola. There are three million Anglicans with 28 Dioceses.

Though a gifted scholar and lawyer, he did not flinch from physical labour; and as Bishop he found himself a homeless outcast in his own diocese, until King Henry III finally accepted his appointment by the Pope. His prayer reflects the commitment and 'stickability' needed by anyone who seeks to be a true follower of Jesus.

Around the end of 350 AD, he succeeded Maximus as Bishop of Jerusalem but was exiled on more than one occasion, due to the enmity of Acacius of Caesarea, and the policies of various emperors. Cyril left important writings documenting the instruction of catechumens and the order of the Liturgy in his day.

Irenaeus was Bishop of Lugdunum in Gaul, then a part of the Roman Empire. He was an early Church Father and apologist, and his writings were formative in the early development of Christian theology.

Friday 29 June *St Peter the Apostle*

Peter, and his brother Andrew, worked as fishermen on the Lake of Galilee. After sharing in the ministry, life and death of Jesus, Peter was the first to address the crowd on the day of Pentecost and undertook the first mission outside Israel to Samaria. He had the revelation that Gentiles must be received into the church as well as Jews and went on missions to Antioch, Corinth and to Rome, where he was martyred about 64 or 65AD.

The Diocese follows the old county boundaries of Durham, the River Tyne to the north and the River Tees to the south, which today means that it includes the southern half of the modern county of Tyne and Wear. The Diocese is part of the Province of York, one of two in England, covering the northern half of England including the Isle of Man.
