

A course created for Christians in Cumbria

September 2017 to July 2018

Penrith, Kendal & Cocker-mouth



CALLED TO SERVE

Called to Serve is designed for Christians who want to grow and discover more of God and God's purposes for them in their faith communities and in the wider world. It's all about...

- Discovering and reflecting on what Scripture tells us about God's Kingdom, God's Church and God's Mission
- Exploring how our faith connects with our everyday lives.
- Discovering our gifts and skills
- Discerning what God might be calling us to be and do.

WHAT IS IT?

Called to Serve will be relaxed, friendly, enjoyable, exciting and practical!

Each session will include:

- a stimulating talk;
- some discussion and personal sharing in regular small groups;
- some practical exercises or activities;
- fellowship, worship and prayer.

In between each of the sessions, you will be asked to do about an hour of "link work".

WHO IS IT FOR?

The Called to Serve course is for those:

- committed and active members of their local church;
- seeking to serve God more fully;
- with a good grasp of the Christian faith and who have already done some Christian learning.

"This course is the 'blue touch paper to fire us up & send us out.'"

The main emphasis will be on "serving God in our daily life and work", but the course can be a helpful part of the journey for those who are exploring some kind of authorised ministry, for example becoming Readers, Local Preachers or Ordained Ministry, or who are training as commissioned Local Lay Ministers. It is a Foundation Course for all kinds of Christian ministry and service and is open to Christians of any denomination.

WHEN IS IT HELD?

Each term the course will involve one Saturday day-conference (10am to 4pm) and five evenings (7pm to 9pm, usually fortnightly).

There will be three terms - the sessions avoid school half-terms and holidays – from 9th September 2017 to 14th July 2018. So 18 meetings all together.

WHERE IS IT HELD?

For the 3 Saturday day conferences we will all meet together at one central venue in Penrith.

To reduce travelling we will run the 15 evening sessions in three centres across Cumbria.

In 2017-18 you can choose between:

- Penrith on Tuesdays
- Cockermouth on Wednesdays
- Kendal on Thursdays

WHAT DOES IT COST?

The fee for Called to Serve will be only £150 for the full year (or £50 paid termly). This will cover all the course materials and teaching.
